## No. 19/17 West Virginia Faces Temple for NIT Season Tip-Off Title

- West Virginia and Temple, former members of the Atlantic 10, will meet for the 71st time in school history.
- WVU is 247-164 all-time in tournaments. Last year, WVU won the Las Vegas Invitational and captured the Puerto Rico Tip-Off in 2014.
- WVU was in the Preseason NIT in 1992 and in 1986. WVU lost at No. 4 Kentucky in 1992 and defeated No. 10 Auburn before losing to St. John's in the 1986 Preseason NIT in Hartford, Connecticut.
- Bob Huggins is in ninth place all-time on the NCAA Division I winningest coaches list. His record now stands at 795-321 in his 35 th season as a head coach. Huggins needs 11 wins to tie Eddie Sutton for eighth place all-time.
- Huggins is the third-winningest active Division I coach behind Mike Krzyzewski and Jim Boeheim.
- Bob Huggins has 2720 -win seasons and 1625 -win seasons in 34 seasons as a head coach.
- Bob Huggins has wins over 34 ranked teams at WVU, including 12 wins over Top 10 teams.
- WVU leads the country in steals per game (13.7), turnover margin (15.7) and turnovers forced (27.0).
- Jevon Carter leads the Big 12 Conference in steals, while Nathan Adrian leads the league in offensive rebounds.
- West Virginia is $106-30$ in the WVU Coliseum under Bob Huggins, including a $55-26$ mark in league games.
- WVU is $515-150(.777)$ all-time at the WVU Coliseum and $147-36$ at the WVU Coliseum in the last 13 seasons.
- WVU's average margin of victory at home last year was +22.4 . WVU averaged 83.3 points per game at home last year.
- Under Bob Huggins in the WVU Coliseum, WVU is averaging 79.0 ppg while holding its opponents to 61.9 ppg .
- West Virginia is 94-25 in non-conference regular season games under Bob Huggins, including a 51-4 mark at home.
- West Virginia is $85-6$ at home against non-conference teams in the last 14 years, including 66 of its last 70 .
- West Virginia is $125-31$ against non-conference teams in regular season games in the last 13 seasons.
- WVU has won 110 of its last 138 non-conference games and 115 of its last 144 non-league contests (includes postseason).
- West Virginia has won 140 of its last 171 games against unranked teams, including 72 of its last 81 at the Coliseum.
- West Virginia made its 27th appearance in the NCAA Championship last season, dating back to 1955.
- WVU finished in second place in the Big 12 Conference regular season and postseason tournament.
- Last season, WVU made its seventh NCAA apperance in the last nine years and ninth appearance in the last 12 seasons.
- WVU has made 12 postseason appearances in the last 13 years, including the NCAA Final Four in 2010.
- WVU led the country last year with its bench averaging 33.3 ppg .
- WVU's bench has scored 30 or more in 25 of the last 31 games. This year's team is averaging 47.5 points from the bench.
- WVU shot 40 percent or better in 25 games last season, including eight games of 50 percent or higher.
- WVU forced 30 or more turnovers in three games last season. WVU had at least seven steals in all but six games and forced 14 or more turnovers in all but five games.
- The Mountaineers have been ranked 63 weeks in the AP poll under Bob Huggins, including 25 weeks in the AP Top 10. Huggins has had WVU ranked more weeks than any other coach in school history. Fred Schaus (1954-60) had WVU ranked for 60 weeks during his career.
- Dating back to last year, WVU has been ranked for 19 consecutive weeks in the AP poll and 36 of the last 39 weeks in the AP rankings.
- West Virginia has been ranked 83 weeks since Jan. 3, 2005 in the AP poll, and 196 weeks total in school history.
- The Mountaineers have won 45 of their last 46 games when holding opponents to 69 points or less.
- WVU outrebounded its opponents on the offensive glass 575 to 312 in 2014-15 and 558 to 306 last season.
- This season, WVU has forced 105 turnovers and has grabbed 66 offensive rebounds in three games.
- West Virginia has made at least one 3-point field goal in 562 consecutive games.
- West Virginia has allowed its opponent to shoot 50 percent or better only 54 times under Bob Huggins ( 315 games).
- WVU is 166-30 under Huggins when holding opponents to 69 points or less. WVU has won 55 of its last 57 and 111 of its last 122 games when holding opponents under 69 points.
- West Virginia is $56-3$ under Bob Huggins when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- West Virginia is 159-27 under Bob Huggins when leading at halftime.
- West Virginia is 167-16 under Bob Huggins when leading by 10 or more points in a game.
- West Virginia is 141-10 under Bob Huggins when posting a higher shooting percentage than its opponent.
- The Mountaineers are 150-26 under Bob Huggins when scoring 70 or more points in a game.
- West Virginia is 153-35 under Bob Huggins when outrebounding its opponent.
- WVU is 5-3 all-time on Nov. 25 and 100-26 all-time in the month of November.

## Scouting Temple

- Temple is 3-2 on the season following an 89-86 win over No. 25 Florida State on Thursday.
- The Owls own wins over La Salle (97-92) and Manhattan (88-67). Temple fell to New Hampshire (57-52) and at Massachusetts (70-67).
- Fran Dunphy is $217-122$ in his 12 th season at Temple. He is $527-285$ as a collegiate head coach.


## Series Record Against Temple

- West Virginia and Temple, former members of the Atlantic 10 Conference, will meet for the 715 time in school history.
- The last game was played on March 12,1998 , an 82-52 WVU win in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- The two teams met every season from 1981 to 1995.
- The first meeting in the series was on Feb. 15, 1929, a 40-29 Temple victory.
- Bob Huggins is 5-4 all-time against Temple. All nine of those meetings came when Huggins was the head coach at Cincinnati.
- West Virginia is 69-63 all-time against current members of the American Athletic Conference.


## WVU Basketball Tradition

- This is the 108th season and 114th year overall for West Virginia basketball, which began in 1903.
- The Mountaineers own a $1,706-1,059$ all-time record in intercollegiate basketball competition, ranking the Mountaineers 23rd in wins among all Division I schools.
- WVU has earned 27 NCAA berths and 16 NIT trips since 1941, and has finished in the Top 2519 times, including an amazing nine straight years from 1955-63.
- In the past 12 years, WVU has reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2015, NIT First Round in 2014, NCAA Second Round in 2012, NCAA Third Round in 2011, the NCAA Final Four in 2010, made the NCAA Tournament in 2009, reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2008, won the NIT in 2007, reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2006 and made it to the NCAA Elite Eight in 2005.
- In 1958, the Mountaineers finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both polls and in 1959, West Virginia, led by All-America guard Jerry West, lost in the NCAA finals to California.
- West Virginia has had 11 first team All-Americans, headlined by West, who went on to become one of basketball's all-time greats with the NBA's Los Angeles Lakers.
- Most recently, Juwan Staten was named to the Lute Olson All-America team in 2015, Da'Sean Butler earned All-America first team honors in 2010 by John Wooden and Basketball Times and Kevin Jones earned All-America first team honors in 2012 by John Wooden.
- Besides West, some of basketball's biggest names have been affiliated with the Old Gold \& Blue, including former Lakers coach and general manager Fred Schaus, former NBA President of Basketball Operations Rod Thorn and former Utah Jazz broadcaster and NBA Hall of Famer "Hot Rod" Hundley.
- West Virginia has played in four different home venues: the ROTC Armory (1903-15), The Ark (1916-27), Stansbury Hall (1928-69) and the WVU Coliseum (1970-present). When the WVU Coliseum was closed due to asbestos removal during the 1999-2000 season, WVU played home games in Charleston, Wheeling and Fairmont.
