QUICK HITTERS

- No. 21/25-ranked West Virginia (1-0) opened its 44th season with an 88-38 win over Charleston Southern on Saturday. The Mountaineers limited the Buccaneers to 11 made field goals, marking the 17th time in program history WVU has held an opponent to 11 or fewer field goals.
- Lanay Montgomery, Tynice Martin and Teana Muldrow each scored 17 points to pace West Virginia. Montgomery grabbed 18 rebounds and Chania Ray dished out 11 assists.
- WVU has now won a school-record 25 consecutive home games against nonconference opponents at the WVU Coliseum. The Mountaineers last dropped a non-league contest at the Coliseum to Ohio State in Nov. 2013.
- Howard (0-1) and WVU meet for the fourth time on Tuesday. WVU holds a 2-1 edge in the series and won the last matchup, 84-61, in Baton Rouge, La.
- West Virginia remains at No. 22 in the Associated Press poll released on Monday.

• Howard (0-1) continues its seven-game road trip with a visit to WVU on Tuesday. The Bison fell in a hard-fought 83-78 contest at Brown on Friday.

• Te'Shya Heslip led the Bison with a gamehigh 23 points, including five three-pointers. Erin Blaine netted 17 career-high points while freshman Asia McCants tallied 10 points in her collegiate debut.

• Preseason All-MEAC selection Syndi Johnson collected eight points and dished out five assists in the loss.

• Howard finished last season 7-24 overall and 4-12 in the MEAC under first-year head coach Ty Grace.

• Howard and WVU last met on Nov. 14, 2006 with the Muntaineers winning, 84-61, at the Basketball Traveler's Classic in Baton Rouge.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Mountaineers prevailed, 88-38, over Charleston Southern in the season-opening win on Saturday. Lanay Montgomery, Teana Muldrow and Tynice Martin scored 17 points each to lead the Mountaineers.
- Montgomery's 17 points and 18 rebound performance was the best for a Mountaineer since Donna Abbott scored 22 points and grabbed 19 rebounds against Rutgers in 1991.
- WVU limited CSU to just 11 made fields, marking the 17th time the Mountaineers have held an opponent to 11 or fewer field goal makes in a game.

WVU CLIMB ONE SPOT TO 21

- West Virginia moved up to No. 21 in the Associated Press Poll released on Monday.
- WVU is No. 25 in the preseason USA TODAY SPORTS Coaches Poll.
- The Mountaineers were in both preseason polls for the fourth time. Other years include: 2014-15 (17 AP/17 Coaches), 2010-11 (11 AP/11 Coaches) and 2007-08 (18 AP/20 Coaches).
- WVU was tabbed to finish fourth in the Big 12 coaches preseason poll.
- Other Big 12 Top 25 teams include: Baylor (2/4), Texas (8/6), Oklahoma (16/18) and West Virginia (21/25).

ALMOST HEAVEN, WEST VIRGINIA

- West Virginia has won a school-record 25 consecutive nonconference games inside the WVU Coliseum dating back to Nov. 24, 2013.
- The Mountaineers' last loss against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum came to Ohio State on Nov. 8, 2013, with WVU falling 70-61.
- The previous record of 19 lasted from Dec. 30, 2008 to Jan. 2, 2011.
- West Virginia is 97-7 (.933) at home against nonconference opponents since 2002.
- WVU has registered nine undefeated seasons at home against nonconference competition in 15 years under Mike Carey.

AN IMPRESSIVE DEBUT

- West Virginia scored 88 points against Charleston Southern on Nov. 12, and outscored an opponent by 50 points for the first time since beating Saint Francis by 55 in Dec. 2014.
- The Mountaineers held CSU to just 11 made field goals, matching the 11 they held Longwood to last season.
- West Virginia has held opponents to 11 or fewer made field goals 17 times since 2002 - all during the Mike Carey era.

CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Gold Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Gold Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Cutline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

MONTGOMERY MAKING HER MARK

- Center Lanay Montgomery opened her senior season with a bang, scoring 17 points and grabbing 18 rebounds in the win over Charleston Southern.
- Montgomery's 17/18 performance is the best for a Mountaineer since Donna Abbott inked 22 points and grabbed 19 rebounds against Rutgers Feb. 1991.
- Montgomery is third all-time at WVU with 232 career blocked shots. She is 39 away from reaching second place currently held by Asya Bussie (270).
- Montgomery's blocked shot total is 10th on the Big 10 Conference's agreet blocks list
- the Big 12 Conference's career blocks list.
 She has 643 total rebounds and is 74 away from reaching WVU's top 10.
- Montgomery is eight rebounds away from passing former teammate Averee Fields (650) for 11th on the list.
- Additionally, Montgomery has corralled 219 career offensive rebounds and is 11 away from reaching the top 10.

MULDROW NEARING 1,000 POINTS

- Junior Teana Muldrow needs 371 points to become the 33rd Mountaineer to reach the 1,000-point club.
- The junior tied for a team-leading 17 points and grabbed seven rebounds in WVU's 88-38 win over Charleston Southern.
- The East Orange, New Jersey, native is the active team leader with 28 games scored in double-figures.

WVU COLISEUM RENOVATIONS

- Construction work continues at a frenetic pace as the finishing touches are being made to West Virginia University's most iconic athletic structure - the WVU Coliseum.
- Phase one work began last spring on the 46-year-old facility's concourse and will continue through December as part of a \$23 million renovation project.
- Phase two will involve seating improvements to the arena's interior and will start at the conclusion of the 2016-17 basketball season. This is by far the most significant upgrade the Coliseum has experienced since the first men's basketball game was played here on December 1, 1970.

Montgomery Achieves Historic Feat in Opener Senior Lanay Montgomery's recorded a historic performance of 17 points and 18 rebounds to pace the No. 22/25 ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team to a season-opening, 88-38, victory over Charleston Southern on Saturday.

West Virginia (1-0) sprinted out to an 11-5 lead before Charleston Southern (0-1) cut the game to 11-9 midway through the first quarter. WVU utilized a 12-2 run and held CSU scoreless for a seven minute stretch that lasted late in the second quarter and the first three minutes of the third quarter. The Mountaineers are now 13-3 all-time in season openers under Mike Carey and 29-15 all-time.

Montgomery was one of three WVU players to score 17 points in the contest and did something a Mountaineer had not accomplished in 25 years. The senior from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, connected a perfect 7-of-7 from the field and added 3-of-4 from the charity stripe in 21 minutes. Montgomery's impressive 17 point and 18 rebound performance was the best for a WVU women's basketball player since Donna Abbott posted 22 points and 19 rebounds against Rutgers on Feb. 28, 1991. The double-double marked the 10th in Montgomery's career and she has now pulled down double-digit boards in back-to-back games.

Overall, West Virginia connected on 50.8 percent (32of-63) from the field and 39.1 percent from behind the arc (9-of-23). The Mountaineers held CSU to just 17.7 percent (11-of-62) shooting, as the Buccaneers became the 17th opponent in WVU program history to only make 11 or less field goals.

West Virginia outmanned Charleston Southern, 60-31, on the boards and outscored CSU 38-2 in the paint. WVU capitalized with 21 second chance points and 24 points off 16 Buccaneers turnovers.

Junior Teana Muldrow scored 17 points, collected seven rebounds, dished out three assists and snatched a pair of steals. Tynice Martin also eclipsed double figures with 17 points, making 7-of-13 from the field and 3-of-7 from the 3-point line.

Chania Ray distributed a career-high 11 assists – the most for a Mountaineer point guard since Linda Stepney recorded 12 against Saint Francis in Dec. 2014. Ray also registered four rebounds and two steals.

A couple of other Mountaineers reach career highs: Anja Martin tallied a personal-best eight points and Desiree Rhodes corralled a new career-high in 12 boards. Kristina King, the Big 12 Conference Preseason Newcomer of the Year, scored eight points in her WVU debut.
