QUICK HITTERS

- No. 19/23-ranked West Virginia (6-0) returns home to the WVU Coliseum, after knocking off Auburn, 56-52, on Thursday to win the Savannah Invitational in Savannah, Georgia.
- Tynice Martin led the team with 16 points, followed by Lanay Montgomery's 13. Montgomery's layup with 12 seconds remaining, put the Mountaineers ahead. Teana Muldrow paced the team by matching a career-high 14 rebounds. Martin was named the Savannah Invitational MVP, while Muldrow garnered All-Tournament Team accolades.
- WVU and High Point (1-3) meet for the second time on Sunday. The Mountaineers won the previous matchup, 89-57, on Dec. 4, 2010, in Morgantown.
- The Mountaineers have won a school-record 27 consecutive games against nonconference opponents at the WVU Coliseum dating back to the 2013-14 season.
- WVU has won seven consecutive games at the Coliseum since Feb. 6, 2016.
- Mike Carey (328-171) will coach his 500th career game at West Virginia on Sunday.

- Taylor Palmer scored 22 points, as WVU made 12 triples en route to a 89-57 win over HPU.

SCOUTING HPU

- High Point (1-3) has lost two consecutive games, including a 75-66 loss at UAB on Tuesday. Other defeats for the Panthers include setbacks to Ole Miss (73-62) and Ohio (76-48). HPU's lone win was an 89-42 victory against Brevard College.
- HPU is averaging 66.2 points per game, while allowing opponents to score 66.5 ppg. The Panthers are shooting 44.4 percent from the field (99-of-223) and limiting opponents to 39.8 percent (98-of-246). From three-point range, High Point has knocked down 23-of-65 for 35.4 percent. High Point has averaged 19.5 turnovers per game for a -4.7 margin.
- Bre Davis paces HPU with 15.0 ppg.
- Preseason All-Big South honoree Kaylah Keys is also in double-figures with 13.5 points per game.
- Shea Morgan is the Panthers' top rebounder, grabbing an average of 6.5 boards per game.

SAVANNAH INVITATIONAL CHAMPS

- Lanay Montgomery's layup with 12 seconds remaining gave the Mountaineers the go-ahead bucket in West Virginia's 56-52 win over Auburn to clinch the Savannah Invitational Championship on Thursday.
- Montgomery finished with 13 points and five rebounds.
- Sophomore Tynice Martin led the team with 16 points and two steals. Teana Muldrow matched a career-best with 14 rebounds, while scoring eight points and dishing out three assists.
- For an seventh consecutive game, West Virginia (6-0) held its opponent to less than 40 percent shooting from the field as Auburn (5-1) only connected on 27.6 percent (16-of-58) of its shots.
- Martin was named the Savannah Invitational MVP after pacing the team with 20.0 points, 3.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in three games.
- Muldrow garnered All-Tournament accolades after averaging a double-double with 14.7 points and 11.0 rebounds in three games.
- WVU has now finished undefeated in nonconference tournaments 15 times.
- With the win, the Mountaineers (6-0) are off to their best start since opening the 2010-11 year 16-0.

PHYSICAL FOR 40 DEFENSE

- West Virginia has limited its first six opponents this season to less than 40 percent shooting and three of those under 30 percent: Charleston Southern (17.7%), Howard (32.0%), Coppin State (22.6%), NC A&T (32.2%), East Carolina (35.8%) and Auburn (27.6%).
- Through six games, opponents are shooting just 27.6 percent (95-of-344) from the field.
- WVU has converted 105 opponent turnovers into 145 points this season.
- The Mountaineers have 59 steals (9.8 spg) on the season and reached double-digit steals in 4-of-6 games: Charleston Southern (11), Howard (15), Coppin St. (10) and East Carolina (11).
- The 11 field goals for Charleston Southern marked the 17th time in program history that WVU has held an opponent to 11 or fewer field goals in a game since 2004.
- In the win over Coppin State, WVU's 14 blocks were the 10th-most in program history and the highest since deflecting 14 against Temple on April 1, 2015.
- The most points allowed in a quarter this season was 24 against NC A&T on Nov. 22.
- ECU was limited to four points in the fourth quarter, tying a record-low for points scored in a quarter by a WVU opponents.

A BLAZING START

- West Virginia, 6-0, is off to its best start since the 2010-11 season, when the Mountaineers finished the nonconference slate undefeated at 13-0 and started the year 16-0.
- Other best season-opening starts under Mike Carey include a 9-0 start in 2004-05 and a 10-0 start in 2002-03.

ALMOST HEAVEN, WEST VIRGINIA

- West Virginia has won a school-record 27 consecutive nonconference games inside the WVU Coliseum dating back to Nov. 24, 2013.
- The Mountaineers last loss against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum came to Ohio State on Nov. 8, 2013, with WVU falling 70-61.
- The previous record of 19 lasted from Dec. 30, 2008 to Jan. 2, 2011.
- West Virginia is 99-7 (.934) at home against nonconference opponents since 2002.
- WVU has registered nine undefeated seasons at home against nonconference competition in 15 years under Mike Carey.

MARTIN ON A ROLL

- Sophomore Tynice Martin has been on fire since Feb. 13, 2016. The sophomore has reached double-figures in 14 of the last 16 contests, including eight consecutive.
- During that stretch, Martin is averaging 16.0 points per game (256 points in 15 games).
- This season, she is averaging 20.5 points per game, which is second in the Big 12.
- West Virginia is 4-0 when Martin scores 20 or more points in a game.
- She netted a career-high 28 points and matched a career-best nine field goals in the win over North Carolina A&T on Nov. 22. Martin added another 27 points against Howard on Nov. 15.
- Martin averaged 20.0 points, 3.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the Savannah Invitational to earn MVP honors - the first regular-season tournament accolade in her career.
- Martin made 30 consecutive free throws from March 18, 2016 to Nov. 24, 2016 - the second longest streak in program history.
- For her career, Martin is shooting 85.7 percent (84-of-98) from the free throw line.
- The Atlanta native is just the third WVU sophomore to finish perfect from the line in double figures after she went 10-of-10 from the charity stripe against Howard (Nov. 15).

NATION'S BEST

- It's still early, but West Virginia sits in the top 10 nationally in multiple statistical categories.
- Through games on Nov. 24, WVU is second nationally in field goal percentage defense (27.6%), eighth in scoring margin (+29.7) and ninth in scoring defense (48.2 ppg).
- Chania Ray is 22nd nationally and leads the Big 12 with 6.3 assists per game.
- Laney Montgomery is 13th in the NCAA, averaging 3.8 offensive rebounds per game.

CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Gold Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Gold Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Cutline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

DURING THE WEEK

Any member of the media wishing to interview a player or member of the coaching staff during the week should contact West Virginia women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance.

Cell phone numbers will not be made available and all WVU student-athletes have been instructed to not conduct interviews without prior approval of the athletic communications staff.

STREAKS OF NOTE

- Lanay Montgomery has blocked at least one shot in 41 of the last 43 contests.
- West Virginia's Tynice Martin has reached double-figure scoring in 14 of her last 16 games, including the last eight contests.
- Martin has made a field goal in 16 consecutive games, while Teana Muldrow has connected on at least one bucket in the last 15 games.
- West Virginia has held its last seven opponents below 40 percent shooting: Ohio State (37.1%), Charleston Southern (17.7%), Howard (32.0%), Coppin State (22.6%), North Carolina A&T (32.2%), East Carolina (35.8%) and Auburn (27.6%).

CAREY COACHES 500TH WVU GAME

- On Sunday against High Point, program all-time wins leader Mike Carey (328-171) will coach his 500th game at West Virginia.
- Carey is in his 16th season at the helm of the Mountaineer women's basketball program.
- Carey collected his 325th win at West Virginia with a 69-39 victory over Coppin State.
- He produced 288 wins at Salem and has 328 victories at West Virginia.
- His .657 winning percentage in 16 seasons at WVU is a program-best.
- Mike Carey (616) recorded his 600th career win at the collegiate level with WVU's 72-35 victory over Kansas on Jan. 16, 2016.
- With a win over Morehead State on Dec. 2, 2015, Carey surpassed Kittie Blakemore as WVU's all-time wins leader.

MONTGOMERY MAKING HER MARK

- Center Lanay Montgomery opened her senior season with a bang, scoring 17 points and grabbing 18 rebounds in the win over Charleston Southern (Nov. 12).
- Montgomery's 17/18 performance is the best for a Mountaineer since Donna Abbott inked 22 points and grabbed 19 rebounds against Rutgers Feb. 1991.
- Montgomery is third all-time at WVU with 247 career blocked shots. She is 24 away from reaching second place currently held by Asya Bussie (270).
- Montgomery's blocked shot total is eighth on the Big 12's career blocks list.
- She has 678 total rebounds and is 38 away from reaching WVU's top 10.
- Additionally, Montgomery has corralled 235 career offensive rebounds, which is seventh. She is 29 away from reaching the top five.
- If trends continue, Montgomery can become the Mountaineers' second-best shooter in program history behind Olayinka Sanni (55.7%). Her career field goal percentage of 55.3 percent currently ranks second all-time at WVU.
